Lower Courts

Our Proposal

Our Club's proposal to take over the administration of the lower courts (near the baseball diamond) and convert the site into dedicated pickleball courts will be posted on the City's Engage Ottawa soon.

The public consultation will run for one month after which the city will decide on our proposal. As soon as it is available, you will receive a link to provide your input to the survey.

The site will allow four dedicated pickleball courts with a half-court practice area. The Club will manage the project and provide most of the funding.

The city will provide a \$10,000 grant and requires the Club to develop a plan to provide some level of free public access to the courts.

Outdoor Tennis and Pickleball Strategy

The city has published a summary of findings from the public consultation on outdoor tennis and pickleball facilities. <u>Outdoor Tennis and Pickleball Strategy | Engage Ottawa</u>

The city will publish its new Outdoor Tennis and Pickleball Strategy in Q3 (by September 30th).

Because we are a municipal club, the strategy will inform our future agreement with the city. The term of our current agreement ends on April 30, 2025.

Changes to Weekly Event Schedule

The Club monitors the registration for weekly events to gauge demand. Weekly, we may release courts set aside for an event to match registration levels as early as 36 hours prior to the event. This allows courts to be reserved, rather than having them sit empty. See our Club's Court Reservation Policy here for details. bf420e 52dc8df06b4e4a69bf79ab733036567b.pdf (orleanstennisclub.ca)

The Tennis and Pickleball Committees also monitor trends and recommend action to the Board. This may include initiatives to support registration demand such as increasing or reducing allocated courts, changing event schedule, etc.

Avoid Disappointment!

REGISTER in CourtReserve if you plan to attend weekly events e.g. Tennis: Daytime, Evening Social, Pickleball: Drop-ins, Leagues, Monday Novice, Friday Social, Drills. Registration opens 7 days +1 hour in advance.

WAITLIST your name if you wish to attend but registration is full. You will be notified if a spot becomes available.

Tennis

- Daytime tennis is back to its 1 PM start time starting in September. This was planned earlier this year with the input of the event ambassador.
- Evening tennis organized play will be reduced to two courts due to lower-than-forecast registration.
- The Club will make our courts available for the Cairine Wilson High School Tennis Club. They will practice from 7:30 - 8:30 AM, two mornings a week (days to be determined) in September and October.

Pickleball

- New Monday Novice Event This is a great opportunity for members looking for a fun, social game
 with other novice players. Karen Liscombe and Chris Cheverie are managing the event, which will
 start with fun drills to work on essential skills.
- Tuesday's mixed intermediate league will return to the 10:30 start time to allow an increase to five courts for this very popular event.
- Drop-Ins:
 - Thursday drop-in will be added back onto the schedule with a new time (8:30-10:00). We are hopeful this timeslot will be well received by members. Considering historically low demand, we have allocated one court to this event.
 - Friday drop-in to increase to five courts based on high demand.
- Saturday skills will be reduced to two courts due to low demand. If there is an uptick in demand this
 can be increased back to three courts.
